This tour gives you the opportunity to observe the striking contrasts that make Athens such a fascinating city. Our expert guide will take you to the centre of the city: CONSTITUTION SQUARE, the HOUSE OF PARLIAMENT, the MEMORIAL TO THE UNKNOWN SOLDIER, the ACADEMY of SCIENCES, the UNIVERSITY and the NATIONAL LIBRARY. Driving down Herod Atticus street you will see the PRESIDENTIAL GUARD (EVZONES) in their picturesque costumes and the PRESIDENTIAL RESIDENCE. On your way to the Acropolis you will see the PANATHENAIC STADIUM (where the first Olympic Games of the modern era were held in 1896) and the Athens of the 2nd century A.D., the TEMPLE OF OLYMPIAN ZEUS and the ADRIAN'S ARCH. On the ACROPOLIS you will visit the architectural masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens: the PROPYLAEA, the temple of ATHENA NIKE, the ERECHTEION and finally, the "harmony between matter and spirit", the monument that "puts order in the mind", the PARTHENON.

Description for tour including the NEW Acropolis Museum:

After this visit follows the visit of the new Acropolis Museum, located on the ancient road that led up to the "sacred rock" in classical times, housing every artifact found on the rock and on its feet, from the Greek Bronze Age to Roman and Byzantine Greece. A walk through its galleries is a walk through history - between the masterpieces of the Archaic and Classical periods, but also in the ancient neighbourhoods of Athens.

Drive along the coastal road, past the wonderful beaches of Glyfada, Vouliagmeni and Varkiza to the most southern point of Attica, Cape SOUNION, where the white marble pillars of the TEMPLE OF POSEIDON stand. On the way you have a splendid view of the SARONIC GULF and the little islands offshore. After visiting the temple of Poseidon you have time to walk at leisure on the rocky promontory of Sounion.

Explore the greatest and only collection around the Universe, of more than 60 reconstructed Ancient Greek musical instruments. Then a pleasant walk through the narrow picturesque streets of Plaka, the old city, will bring you a Typical Greek Tavern where you will enjoy your dinner following a floor show with live music and Greek Folk Dances in traditional costumes.

Drive through the fertile plain of Boeotia, crossing the towns of THEBES connected with the tragedy of Oedipus - LEVADIA and ARACHOVA, famous for its colourful rugs and carpets (short stop on the way back). Arrive at DELPHI, the centre of the Ancient World - the "Omphalos" (navel) of the Earth - whose prestige extended far beyond the boundaries of the Hellenic world. On the slopes of Mount Parnassus, in a landscape of unparalleled beauty and majesty, lie the ruins of the SANCTUARY OF APOLLO PYTHIOS. Visit the TREASURY OF THE ATHENIANS, the TEMPLE OF APOLLO and the MUSEUM containing such masterpieces of Ancient Greek sculpture as the Athlete Agias and the famous bronze Charioteer. Lunch (optional) in the modern village of Delphi, return to Athens by the same route.

Leave by the coastal road along the SARONIC GULF to the CANAL OF CORINTH which connects the Ionian Sea with the Aegean Sea (short stop). Drive on to MYCENAE, the Homeric city of the Atrides - the city "rich in gold" of the ancient poets. Visit the LION'S GATE, the CYCLOPEAN WALLS, the ROYAL TOMBS. Depart for

NAUPLIA through the fertile plain of Argolis, the picturesque town nestling at the foot of a cliff crowned by the mighty ramparts of PALAMIDI FORTRESS. After lunch leave for EPIDAUROS to visit the THEATRE (4th century B.C.) famous for its astonishing acoustics. Return to Athens by the National Road.

Day 1: Leave for Delphi via Thebes, Levadia and the picturesque village of Arachova, on the slopes of Mount Parnassus, arrive in Delphi and visit the Archaeological Site. After the visit depart for Kalambaka, passing through picturesque villages and towns of Central Greece. Dinner and overnight.
Day 2: Visit Meteora and enjoy a unique and most impressive scenery with ageless Monasteries, containing priceless historical and religious treasures, standing between earth and sky atop huge rocks. Return to Athens via Trikala, Lamia, Thermopylae (short stop to see across the road the Leonida's Monument), arrive in Athens early in the evening.

Day 1: Leave by the coastal road to the Corinth Canal (short stop). Drive on and visit the Theatre of Epidauros, famous for its remarkable acoustics. Then proceed to the town of Nauplion (short photo stop), drive on to Mycenae and visit the Archaeological Site and the Tomb of Agamemnon. Then depart for Olympia through Central Peloponnese and the towns of Tripolis and Megalopolis. Overnight in Olympia, the cradle of the Olympic Games. (Dinner)

Day 2: In the morning visit the Archaeological Site with the Sanctuary of Olympian Zeus, the Ancient Stadium and the Archaeological Museum. Then drive on through the plains of Eliad and Achaia until the magnificent bridge which is crossing the Corinthian Bay from Rion to Antirion. Pass by the picturesque towns of Nafpactos (Lepanto) and Itea, arrive in Delphi. Overnight. (Dinner)

Day 3: In the morning visit the Archaeological Site and the Museum. Depart for Kalambaka, a small town stated at the foot of the astonishing complex of Meteora, gigantic rocks. Overnight. (Dinner)

Day 4: Visit Meteora, among striking scenery, perched on top of huge rocks which seem to be suspended in mid-air, stand ageless Monasteries, where you can see exquisite specimens of Byzantine art. Return to Athens via Trikala, Lamia, Thermopylae (short stop to see across the road the Leonida's Monument). Arrive in Athens early in the evening.
