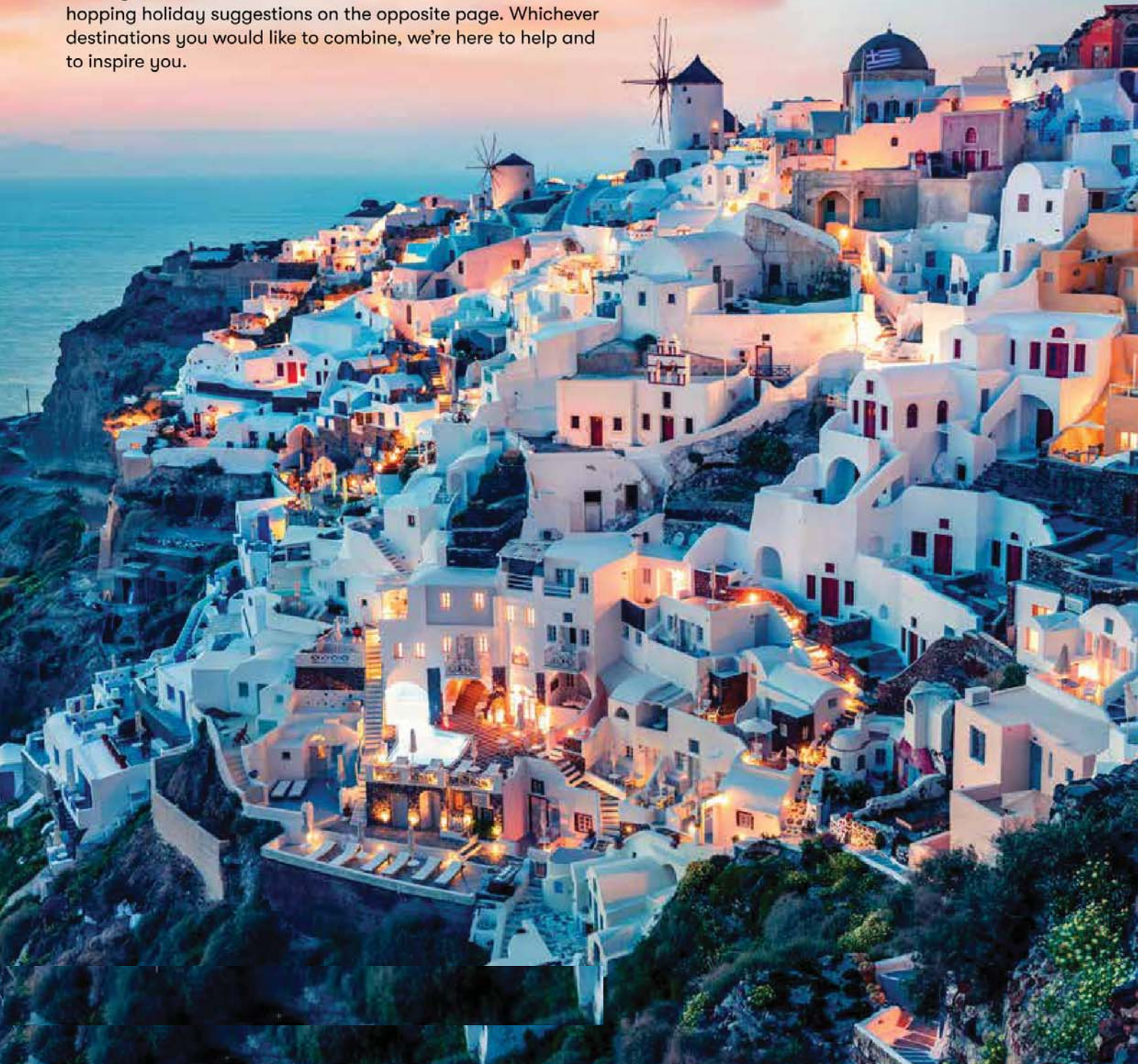


Island hopping

Skiathos Town

Board the hydrofoil, or more leisurely ferry, from Skiathos Town to Skopelos. Stroll, from the pretty old town with its winding cobbled streets, tavernas, cafés and bars, along the seafront and visit the sights made famous in the Mamma Mia movie.



Rethymnon, Crete

CRETE AND SANTORINI

Enjoy a few days on the rugged and mountainous island of Crete, widely regarded as a country within a country for its ancient history, vast landscape and long summer. Board the ferry to glide through dazzling Aegean waters en route to the stunning and spectacular island of Santorini.
